As of August 5, 2021(THU)

On August 4 (WED), the number of new cases reached a record high of 752. We would like to inform you that the prefectural government has issued the "Fukuoka Special Corona Alert" today and requested the national government to declare a state of emergency to this prefecture.

Circumstance for the indicators of the Fukuoka Corona Alert

If the current infection situation continues, it could become a even more serious situation that we have never experienced before. The peak in the number of hospitalized patients tends to arrive later than the peak in the number of new positive patients, and there is concern that medical institutions will become overburdened in the future.



For this reason we have issued the "Fukuoka Special Corona Alert"

What measures will be in place

Prefectural Facilities

Closed

In accordance with the "Fukuoka Corona Special Alert" prefectural facilities will be closed from August 6 (FRI).

As for other measures, since changing these measures in a short period of time will cause confusion among businesses, the current measures will continue until the state of emergency is declared in Fukuoka Prefecture.

Also, please continue to refrain from unnecessary outings, as we have been asking you to do.

This is a critical moment. We must do everything we can to stop the further spread of the infection. We would like to ask for everyone's cooperation.
